In accordance with a mutual desire to promote activities between our parties, Southern Center of Emergency Response for Toxic Substance Incidents and Siberian State University of Geosystems and Technologies, agree to the following statement of intent on educational and research cooperation.

Cooperation and development of activities may extend to any fields and subjects in which the two parties may identify shared interests, in particular, in explosion safety of technological processes, industrial and civil constructions. Cooperation in specific areas must be designated by mutual consent and incorporated into specific additional written agreements with signature by the appropriate party authorities.

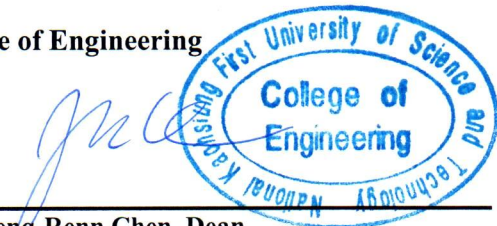
The two parties agree to the following general areas of interest and cooperation:

1. The exchange of scholars and scientists to conduct research of mutual interest.
2. The exchange of professors for lectures and short term visits.
3. Invitations to scholars for participation in conferences, symposia and instruction.
4. Exchange of information, academic materials and publications in fields of mutual interests.
5. Facilitating the mobility of students, through exchange and visits between the two parties.

Both parties agree that all financial arrangements necessary to implement this Memorandum of Understanding or any subsequent agreement must be negotiated according to the regulations of each party, set forth in a written agreement and depends on the availability of funds. Both parties recognize that this Memorandum of Understanding establishes a foundation of mutual understanding and interest and does not in itself entail any financial obligations for either party.

This understanding will remain in effect until one party notifies the other of its wish to terminate the agreement.
